BASIC SWAT SCHOOL

Training hours: 70hrs.

Course Description

The course will be physically and mentally demanding and will consist of long training days. Physical fitness assessment and shoot-in on the first day. A minimum 90% score on the Georgia Double-Action Pistol course will be required. The curriculum will cover basic SWAT tactics and movements, live-fire shoot house and flat range training, woodland operations, flash-sound diversionary device familiarization, chemical munitions familiarization, and confined space/elevated platform training.

Supplies Needed

800 rounds of rifle ammunition, 500 rounds of pistol ammunition, 200 rounds of frangible pistol ammunition, Vest, Duty Belt, holster, rifle sling, magazine holders, gas mask, eye and ear protection, etc.

Cost \$100.00 per registrant.

This cost covers all meals, lodging and shuttle transportation to and from lodging and training facility for officer safety reasons. Upon successful completion SWAT Pins will be awarded.
